# Hymns & Readings

## **Troparion of the resurrection, Tone I —**

When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, while the soldiers were guarding Thy most-pure body, Thou didst rise on the third-day, O Saviour, granting life to the world; the powers-of-heaven, therefore, cried to Thee, O giver-of-life: 'Glory to Thy resurrection, O Christ; glory to Thy kingdom; glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou that lovest mankind'.

## **Troparion, Tone VIII —**

Thou art most-glorious, O Christ our God, Who hast established the holy fathers as lights on the earth; through them, Thou hast guided us to the true faith: O greatly-compassionate One, glory to Thee.

*Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.*

## **Kontakion, Tone VI —**

The Son, Who shone forth from the Father, was, ineffably, born, two-fold-in-nature, of a woman: having beheld Him, we deny not the image of His form; but we depict it piously, and revere it faithfully; and, keeping the true faith, the Church venerateth the icon of Christ incarnate.

*Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.*

## **Kontakion of the resurrection, Tone I —**

As God, Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory, raising the world with Thyself; human nature praiseth Thee as God; for death hath vanished: Adam exulteth, O Master; Eve rejoiceth; for she is freed from bondage, and crieth to Thee: 'Thou art the giver-of-resurrection-to-all, O Christ'.

## **Prokeimenon & Readings:**

**Tone 1:** Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us / as we have set our hope on Thee! (*Resurrection*)

*Rejoice in the Lord, O you righteous! Praise befits the just!*

**Tone 4:** Blessed art Thou, O Lord God of our fathers, / and praised and glorified is Thy name forever! (*Song of the Fathers*)

**E**pistle: (2 Corinthians 9:6-11) Brethren, "He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. <sup>7</sup> So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. <sup>8</sup> And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work. <sup>9</sup> As it is written: "He has dispersed abroad, He has given to the poor; His righteousness endures forever." <sup>10</sup> Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness, <sup>11</sup> while you are enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God.

**Alleluia Verses:**

*God gives vengeance unto me, and subdues people under me.*

*He magnifies the salvation of the King and deals mercifully with David, His anointed, and his seed forever.*

*The Lord, the God of gods, speaks and summons the earth from the rising of the sun to its setting.*

**G**ospel: (Luke 7:11-16) At that time, Jesus went into a city called Nain; and many of His disciples went with Him, and a large crowd. <sup>12</sup> And when He came near the gate of the city, behold, a dead man was being carried out, the only son of his mother; and she was a widow. And a large crowd from the city was with her. <sup>13</sup> When the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her and said to her, "Do not weep." <sup>14</sup> Then He came and touched the open coffin, and those who carried him stood still. And He said, "Young man, I say to you, arise." <sup>15</sup> So he who was dead sat up and began to speak. And He presented him to his mother. <sup>16</sup> Then fear came upon all, and they glorified God, saying, "A great prophet has risen up among us"; and, "God has visited His people."
