Troparion of the resurrection, Tone I —

When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, while the soldiers were guarding Thy most-pure body, Thou didst rise on the third-day, O Saviour, granting life to the world; the powers-of-heaven, therefore, cried to Thee, O giver-of-life: 'Glory to Thy resurrection, O Christ; glory to Thy kingdom; glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou that lovest mankind'.

Troparion, Tone IV —

In truth, thou wast revealed, to thy flock, as a rule of faith, an image of humility, and a teacher of abstinence; thy humility exalted thee; and thy poverty enriched thee: O hierarch Father Nicholas, entreat Christ our God, that our souls may be saved.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.


Kontakion, Tone III —

Kontakion of the resurrection, Tone I —

As God, Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory, raising the world with Thyself; human nature praiseth Thee as God; for death hath vanished: Adam exulteth, O Master; Eve rejoiceth; for she is freed from bondage, and crieth to Thee: 'Thou art the giver-of-resurrection-to-all, O Christ'.



Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone 1: Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us / as we have set our hope on Thee! (*Resurrection*)

v. In Judah God is known; His name is great in Israel.

Tone 7: The righteous shall rejoice in the Lord, / and shall hope in Him. (St. Nicholas)

pistle: (Hebrews 13:17-21) Brethren, obey those who rule over you, and be submissive, for they watch out for your souls, as those who must give account. Let them do so with joy and not with grief, for that would be unprofitable for you. ¹⁸ Pray for us; for we are confident that we have a good conscience, in all things desiring to live honorably. ¹⁹ But I especially urge you to do this, that I may be restored to you the sooner. ²⁰ Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, ²¹ make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Gospel: (Luke 6:17-23) At that time, Jesus stood on a level place with a crowd of His disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea and Jerusalem, and from the seacoast of Tyre and Sidon, who came to hear Him and be healed of their diseases, ¹⁸ as well as those who were tormented with unclean spirits. And they were healed. ¹⁹ And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and healed them all. ²⁰ Then He lifted up His eyes toward His disciples, and said: "Blessed are you poor, For yours is the kingdom of God. ²¹ Blessed are you who hunger now, For you shall be filled. Blessed are you who weep now, For you shall laugh. ²² Blessed are you when men hate you, And when they exclude you, And revile you, and cast out your name as evil, For the Son of Man's sake. ²³ Rejoice in that day and leap for joy! For indeed your reward is great in heaven, For in like manner their fathers did to the prophets.
