Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone VII -

By Thy Cross Thou didst destroy death. To the thief Thou didst open Paradise. For the Myrrhbearers Thou didst change weeping into joy, and Thou didst command Thy disciples, O Christ God, to proclaim that Thou art risen, granting the world great mercy.

Troparion of St. Anthony, Tone IV -

Thou didst imitate the ways of zealous Elijah, and didst follow the straight path of John the Baptist. Thou didst become a desert-dweller, strengthening the world by thy prayers. O Father Anthony, intercede with Christ God that our souls may be saved!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion of St. Anthony, Tone II -

Thou didst reject the tumult of this life living thy life to the end in solitude, imitating the Baptist in every way. With him we honor thee, most venerable Anthony, the foundation of the Fathers.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone VII -

The dominion of death can no longer hold men captive, for Christ descended, shattering and destroying its powers. Hell is bound, while the Prophets rejoice and cry: "The Savior has come to those in faith; enter, you faithful, into the Resurrection!"

Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone 7: The Lord shall give strength to His people. / The Lord shall bless His people with peace. (*Resurrection*)

v. Offer to the Lord, O you sons of God! Offer young rams to the Lord!

Tone 7: Precious in the sight of the Lord / is the death of His saints. (St. Anthony)

pistle: (Colossians 1:12-18) Brethren, ¹² giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. ¹³ He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, ¹⁴ in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins. ¹⁵ He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. ¹⁶ For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. ¹⁷ And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist. ¹⁸ And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.

To declare Thy mercy in the morning, and Thy truth by night.

Blessed is the man who fears the Lord, who greatly delights in His commandments.

Gospel: (Luke 8:18-27) At that time, ¹⁸ Now a certain ruler asked Him, saying, "Good Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?" ¹⁹ So Jesus said to him, "Why do you call Me good? No one *is* good but One, that is, God. ²⁰ You know the commandments: 'Do not commit adultery,' 'Do not murder,' 'Do not steal,' 'Do not bear false witness,' 'Honor your father and your mother.' " ²¹ And he said, "All these things I have kept from my youth." ²² So when Jesus heard these things, He said to him, "You still lack one thing. Sell all that you have and distribute to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me." ²³ But when he heard this, he became very sorrowful, for he was very rich. ²⁴ And when Jesus saw that he became very sorrowful, He said, "How hard it is for those who have riches to enter the kingdom of God! ²⁵ For it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God." ²⁶ And those who heard it said, "Who then can be saved?" ²⁷ But He said, "The things which are impossible with men are possible with God."


