Hymns & Readings

Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone III —

Let the heavens rejoice; let the earth be glad; for the Lord hath shewn strength with His arm; He hath trampled down death by death; He hath become the first-born of the dead; He hath delivered us from the depths-of -hell, and hath granted, unto the world, great mercy.

Troparion, Tone I —

A desert-dweller, an angel in the flesh, and a worker of wonders, thou, O our God-bearing father Auxentius, wast shewn to be; for, having acquired heavenly gifts through fasting, vigilance, and prayer, thou healest the infirm, and the souls of them that have recourse to thee with faith; glory to Him that gave thee strength; glory to Him that hath crowned thee; glory to Him that, through thee, worketh healings for all.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, Tone II —

Delighting, O godly-wise one, in abstinence, and restraining the desires of thy flesh, thou hast been shewn as shining with faith, and hast blossomed, like a plant, in the midst of paradise, O Auxentius, sacred father.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone III —

On this day, Thou didst rise from the tomb, O merciful One, leading us from the gates-of-death: on this day, Adam exulteth, as Eve rejoiceth; with the prophets, and patriarchs, they, unceasingly, praise the divine majesty-of-Thy-power.



Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone 3: Sing praises to our God, sing praises! / Sing praises to our King, sing praises! (*Resurrection*)

v. Clap your hands, all peoples! Shout to God with loud songs of joy!

Pistle: (1 Timothy 4:9-15) Timothy my son, is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance. ¹⁰ For to this end we both labor and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Savior of all men, especially of those who believe. ¹¹ These things command and teach. ¹² Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity. ¹³ Till I come, give attention to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine. ¹⁴ Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the eldership. ¹⁵ Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all.

Alleluia Verses:

In Thee, O Lord, have I hoped; let me never be put to shame!

Be a God of protection for me, a house of refuge in order to save me!

Gospel: (Luke 19:1-10) At that time, Jesus entered and passed through Jericho. ² Now behold, there was a man named Zacchaeus who was a chief tax collector, and he was rich. ³ And he sought to see who Jesus was, but could not because of the crowd, for he was of short stature. ⁴ So he ran ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see Him, for He was going to pass that way. ⁵ And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up and saw him, and said to him, "Zacchaeus, make haste and come down, for today I must stay at your house." ⁶ So he made haste and came down, and received Him joyfully. ⁷ But when they saw it, they all complained, saying, "He has gone to be a guest with a man who is a sinner." ⁸ Then Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord, I give half of my goods to the poor; and if I have taken anything from anyone by false accusation, I restore fourfold." ⁹ And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because he also is a son of Abraham; ¹⁰ for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."
