#### Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone III —

Let the heavens rejoice; let the earth be glad: for the Lord hath shewn strength with His arm; He hath trampled down death by death; He hath become the first-born of the dead; He hath delivered us from the depths of hell, and hath granted, unto the world, great mercy.

#### Troparion, Tone IV —

Prepare, O Zebulon; and adorn thyself, O Naphtali; River Jordan, cease flowing; and receive, with joy, the Master coming to be baptized; Adam, rejoice with our first mother; and hide not yourselves, as ye did, of old, in paradise: for, having seen you naked, He hath appeared to clothe you with the first garment; Christ hath appeared to renew all creation.

Forsaking the beauty of the world, and the corruption therein, O venerable one, thou hast settled in the monastery of Saróv: and, having lived there as an angel, thou hast become, for many, the way to salvation: for which sake, Christ hath, also, glorified thee, O father Seraphim, enriching thee with the gift both of healings and of miracles; wherefore, we cry out unto thee: 'Rejoice, O Seraphim, our venerable father'.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Today, the Lord entereth the Jordan, and crieth out to John: 'Be not afraid to baptize Me: for I have come to save Adam, the first-formed man'.

Gospel: (Mark 1:1-8) The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. <sup>2</sup> As it is written in the Prophets: "Behold, I send My messenger before Your face, Who will prepare Your way before You." <sup>3</sup> "The voice of one crying in the wilderness: 'Prepare the way of the LORD; Make His paths straight.'" <sup>4</sup> John came baptizing in the wilderness and preaching a baptism of repentance for the remission of sins. <sup>5</sup> Then all the land of Judea, and those from Jerusalem, went out to him and were all baptized by him in the Jordan River, confessing their sins. <sup>6</sup> Now John was clothed with camel's hair and with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. <sup>7</sup> And he preached, saying, "There comes One after me who is mightier than I, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to stoop down and loose. <sup>8</sup> I indeed baptized you with water, but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."


