Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone III —

Let the heavens rejoice; let the earth be glad: for the Lord hath shewn strength with His arm; He hath trampled down death by death; He hath become the first-born of the dead; He hath delivered us from the depths of hell, and hath granted, unto the world, great mercy.

Troparion, Tone IV —

Leaving behind the tumult of the world, rejecting the world, in accordance with the Gospel, thou hast followed Christ: and, living a life equal to the angels, unto the calm haven of the holy mountain of Athos hast thou attained, from whence, with the blessing of the fathers, going to the mountain of Kiev, and living, there, an industrious life, hast enlightened thy homeland, and, unto a multitude of monastics, shewing the path that leadeth to the kingdom of heaven, hast lead them unto Christ: to Whom, pray thou, O venerable Anthony, that He save our souls.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, Tone VIII —

Having cleaved unto God, loving Whom, above all, from thy youth, O venerable one, with all thy soul, with love, thou hast followed Him: and, holding the corrupt world to be as naught, thou hast make a cave in the ground, and, struggling well, therein, against the snares of the invisible foe, like the radiant sun, upon all the ends of the earth, hast shone forth: wherefore, in gladness, thou hast passed over to the mansions of heaven; and, now, with the angels, standing before the throne of the Master, be thou mindful of us that honour thy memory, that we may cry out to thee: 'Rejoice, O Anthony our father'.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone III —

On this day, Thou didst rise from the tomb, O merciful One, leading us from the gates of death: on this day, Adam exulteth, as Eve rejoiceth; with the prophets, and patriarchs, they, unceasingly, praise the divine majesty of Thy power.

Verse: Clap your hands, all peoples! Shout to God with loud songs of joy!

Tone 7: Precious in the sight of the Lord / is the death of His saints. (St. Anthony)

pistle: (Romans 6:18-23) Brethren, having been set free from sin, you became slaves of righteousness. ¹⁹ I speak in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as slaves of uncleanness, and of lawlessness leading to more lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves of righteousness for holiness. ²⁰ For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. ²¹ What fruit did you have then in the things of which you are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death. ²² But now having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life. ²³ For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Gospel: (Matthew 8:5-13) At that time, when Jesus had entered Caperna-**9** um, a centurion came to Him, pleading with Him, ⁶ saying, "Lord, my servant is lying at home paralyzed, dreadfully tormented." ⁷ And Jesus said to him, "I will come and heal him." 8 The centurion answered and said, "Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed. ⁹ For I also am a man under authority, having soldiers under me. And I say to this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and to another, 'Come,' and he comes; and to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it." ¹⁰ When Jesus heard it, He marveled, and said to those who followed, "Assuredly, I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel! 11 And I say to you that many will come from east and west, and sit down with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven. ¹² But the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth." ¹³Then Jesus said to the centurion, "Go your way; and as you have believed, so let it be done for you." And his servant was healed that same hour.


