Hymns & Readings

Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone I — When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, while the soldiers were guarding Thy most-pure body, Thou didst rise, on the third day, O Saviour, granting life to the world; the powers of heaven, therefore, cried to Thee, O giver of life: 'Glory to Thy resurrection, O Christ: glory to Thy kingdom: glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou that lovest mankind'.

Troparion, Tone VIII — As the bountiful harvest of Thy sowing of salvation, the lands of North America offer, to Thee, O Lord, all the saints that have shone in them; by their prayers, keep the Church, and our land, in abiding peace, through the Theotokos, O most-merciful One.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, Tone III — Today, the choir of saints that were pleasing to God in the lands of North America, now, standeth before us, in the Church, and, invisibly, prayeth to God for us; with them, the angels glorify Him; and all the saints of the Church of Christ keep festival with them; and, together, they all pray, for us, to the pre-eternal God.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone I — As God, Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory, raising the world with Thyself; human nature praiseth Thee as God; for death hath vanished: Adam exulteth, O Master; Eve rejoiceth; for she is freed from bondage, and crieth to Thee: 'Thou art the giver of resurrection to all, O Christ'.



Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone I: Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us / as we have set our hope on Thee! (*Resurrection*)

Verse: Rejoice in the Lord, O you righteous! Praise befits the just!

Tone VII: Precious in the sight of the Lord / is the death of His saints. (All Saints of America)

Tpistle: (Romans 2:10-16) Brethren, glory, honor, and peace to everyone who works what is good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. ¹¹ For there is no partiality with God. ¹² For as many as have sinned without law will also perish without law, and as many as have sinned in the law will be judged by the law ¹³ (for not the hearers of the law are just in the sight of God, but the doers of the law will be justified; ¹⁴ for when Gentiles, who do not have the law, by nature do the things in the law, these, although not having the law, are a law to themselves, ¹⁵ who show the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and between themselves their thoughts accusing or else excusing them) ¹⁶ in the day when God will judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ, according to my gospel.

Gospel: (Matthew 4:18-23) At that time, Jesus, was walking by the Sea of Galilee, saw two brothers, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen. ¹⁹ Then He said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men." ²⁰ They immediately left *their* nets and followed Him. ²¹ Going on from there, He saw two other brothers, James *the son* of Zebedee, and John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets. He called them, ²² and immediately they left the boat and their father, and followed Him. ²³ And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.
