

<u>The First Antiphon:</u> Make a joyful noise to God, all the earth! Sing of His Name, give glory to His praise!

Refrain: Through the prayers of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us!

<u>The Third Antiphon:</u> (Reader) Those who trust in the Lord are like Mount Zion, which cannot be moved, but abides forever.

Troparion/Refrain, Tone VII - Thou wast transfigured on the mountain, O Christ God, revealing Thy glory to Thy disciples, as far as they could bear it: let Thine everlasting light also shine upon us sinners, through the prayers of the Theotokos; O giver of light, glory to Thee.

As the mountains are round about it, so the Lord is round about His people, from this time and forevermore. $\it R$

O Lord, who shall sojourn in Thy tabernacle? Who shall dwell on Thy holy mountain? \boldsymbol{R}

Who shall ascend the mountain of the Lord? And who shall stand in His holy place? \boldsymbol{R}

<u>Deacon/Entrance Verse</u>: Send out Thy light and Thy truth; they have led me and brought me to Thy holy mountain. *R*

Kontakion, Tone VII - On the mountain, Thou wast transfigured, O Christ God; and Thy disciples beheld Thy glory, as far as they could see it: so that, when they should behold Thee crucified, they would understand that Thy suffering was voluntary, and would proclaim, to the world, that Thou art, truly, the radiance of the Father.

pistle: (2 Peter 1:10-19) Brethren, be even more diligent to make your call and election sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble; ¹¹ for so an entrance will be supplied to you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. 12 For this reason I will not be negligent to remind you always of these things, though you know and are established in the present truth. ¹³ Yes, I think it is right, as long as I am in this tent, to stir you up by reminding you, 14 knowing that shortly I must put off my tent, just as our Lord Jesus Christ showed me. 15 Moreover I will be careful to ensure that you always have a reminder of these things after my decease. ¹⁶ For we did not follow cunningly devised fables when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of His majesty. ¹⁷ For He received from God the Father honor and glory when such a voice came to Him from the Excellent Glory: "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." 18 And we heard this voice which came from heaven when we were with Him on the holy mountain ¹⁹ And so we have the prophetic word confirmed, which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts;

Gospel: (Matthew 17:1-9) After six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, led them up on a high mountain by themselves; ² and He was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as the light. ³ And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Him. ⁴ Then Peter answered and said to Jesus, "Lord, it is good for us to be here; if You wish, let us make here three tabernacles: one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." ⁵ While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them; and suddenly a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!" ⁶ And when the disciples heard *it*, they fell on their faces and were greatly afraid. ⁷ But Jesus came and touched them and said, "Arise, and do not be afraid." ⁸ When they had lifted up their eyes, they saw no one but Jesus only. ⁹ Now as they came down from the mountain, Jesus commanded them, saying, "Tell the vision to no one until the Son of Man is risen from the dead."
