## Hymns & Readings

**Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone I** — When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, while the soldiers were guarding Thy most-pure body, Thou didst rise, on the third day, O Saviour, granting life to the world; the powers of heaven, therefore, cried to Thee, O giver of life: 'Glory to Thy resurrection, O Christ: glory to Thy kingdom: glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou that lovest mankind'.

**Troparion, Tone VII** — Thou wast transfigured on the mountain, O Christ God, revealing Thy glory to Thy disciples, as far as they could bear it: let Thine everlasting light also shine upon us sinners, through the prayers of the Theotokos; O giver of light, glory to Thee.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

**Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone I** — As God, Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory, raising the world with Thyself; human nature praiseth Thee as God; for death hath vanished: Adam exulteth, O Master; Eve rejoiceth; for she is freed from bondage, and crieth to Thee: 'Thou art the giver of resurrection to all, O Christ'.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

**Kontakion, Tone VII** — On the mountain, Thou wast transfigured, O Christ God; and Thy disciples beheld Thy glory, as far as they could see it: so that, when they should behold Thee crucified, they would understand that Thy suffering was voluntary, and would proclaim, to the world, that Thou art, truly, the radiance of the Father.

#### Prokeimenon & Readings:

**Tone IV:** O Lord, how manifold are Thy works; / in wisdom hast Thou made them all. (Feast)

Verse: Bless the Lord, O my soul! O Lord, my God, Thou art very great!

**Tone I:** My mouth shall speak wisdom; / the meditation of my heart shall be understanding. (St. Tikhon)

**Pistle:** (1 Corinthians 4:9-16) Brethren, I think that God has displayed us, the apostles, last, as men condemned to death; for we have been made a spectacle to the world, both to angels and to men. <sup>10</sup> We are fools for Christ's sake, but you are wise in Christ! We are weak, but you are strong! You are distinguished, but we are dishonored! <sup>11</sup> To the present hour we both hunger and thirst, and we are poorly clothed, and beaten,

and homeless. <sup>12</sup> And we labor, working with our own hands. Being reviled, we bless; being persecuted, we endure; <sup>13</sup> being defamed, we entreat. We have been made as the filth of the world, the offscouring of all things until now. <sup>14</sup> I do not write these things to shame you, but as my beloved children I warn *you*. <sup>15</sup> For though you might have ten thousand instructors in Christ, yet *you do* not *have* many fathers; for in Christ Jesus I have begotten you through the gospel. <sup>16</sup> Therefore I urge you, imitate me.

#### **Alleluia Verses:**

The heavens are Thine, the earth also is Thine!

Blessed are the people who know the festal shout!

The mouth of the righteous shall proclaim wisdom, and his tongue shall speak of judgment.

Gospel: (Matthew 17:14-23) At that time, a man came to Him, kneeling down to Him and saying, <sup>15</sup> "Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and suffers severely; for he often falls into the fire and often into the water. <sup>16</sup> So I brought him to Your disciples, but they could not cure him." <sup>17</sup> Then Jesus answered and said, "O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I bear with you? Bring him here to Me." <sup>18</sup> And Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him; and the child was cured from that very hour. <sup>19</sup> Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, "Why could we not cast it out?" <sup>20</sup> So Jesus said to them, "Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you. <sup>21</sup> However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting." <sup>22</sup> Now while they were staying in Galilee, Jesus said to them, "The Son of Man is about to be betrayed into the hands of men, <sup>23</sup> and they will kill Him, and the third day He will be raised up." And they were exceedingly sorrowful.

**In place of 'It is truly meet...'** — Magnify, O my soul, the Lord that was transfigured on Mount Tabor. Thy childbearing was without corruption: God came forth from thy body clothed in flesh, and appeared, on earth, and dwelt among men; therefore, we, all, magnify thee, O Theotokos.

**Communion Hymn:** Praise the Lord from the heavens; praise Him in the highest. O Lord, we will walk in the light of Thy countenance, and will exult in Thy name forever. Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia.


