Hymns & Readings

Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone V — Let us, the faithful, praise, and worship, the Word, co-eternal with the Father, and the Spirit, born, for our salvation, from the Virgin: for He willed to be lifted up on the cross in the flesh, to endure death, and to raise the dead, by His glorious resurrection.

Troparion, Tone IV — Thy nativity, O Virgin, hath proclaimed joy to the whole universe: the sun of righteousness, Christ our God, hath shone from thee, O Theotokos; by annulling the curse, He bestowed a blessing; by destroying death, He hath granted us eternal life.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone V — Thou didst descend into hell, O my Saviour, shattering its gates, as almighty, resurrecting the dead, as Creator, and destroying the sting of death; Thou hast delivered Adam from the curse, O lover of man; and we cry unto Thee: 'O Lord, save us'.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Kontakion, Tone IV — By thy nativity, most-pure Virgin, Joachim and Anna are freed from barrenness, Adam and Eve, from the corruption of death; and we, thy people, freed from the guilt of sin, celebrate, and sing to thee: 'The barren woman giveth birth to the Theotokos, the nourisher of our life'.

Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone III: The Lord is my light and my Saviour: Whom shall I fear?

Verse: The Lord is the strength of my life: of whom then shall I be afraid?

Tone III: My soul doth magnify the Lord, / and my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Savior. (Song of the Theotokos)

pistle: (Romans 6:3-11) Brethren: Do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection, knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. For he who has died has been freed from sin. Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, knowing that Christ,

having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him. For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God. Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Alleluia Verses:

I have exalted one chosen out of My people.

For My hand shall defend him and My arm shall strengthen him.

Hearken, O daughter, and see, and incline thine ear!

Gospel: (Matthew 28:16-20) At that time, the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, to the mountain which Jesus had appointed for them. When they saw Him, they worshiped Him; but some doubted. And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

Instead of "It is truly meet...," we sing: Magnify, O my soul, the most glorious birth of the Mother of God! Virginity is foreign to mothers; childbearing is strange for virgins. But in thee, O Theotokos, both were accomplished. Therefore all we nations of the earth unceasingly magnify thee.

Communion Hymn: Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest! I will receive the cup of salvation and call on the Name of the Lord. Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia!
