Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone VI — The angelic powers were at Thy tomb; the guards became as dead men: Mary stood by Thy grave, seeking Thy most-pure body; Thou didst capture hell, not being tempted by it: Thou didst come to the Virgin, granting life; O Lord, Who didst rise from the dead, glory to Thee.

Troparion, Tone I — O Lord, save Thy people; and bless Thine inheritance; grant victories to the Orthodox Christians over their adversaries; and, by virtue of Thy cross, preserve Thy habitation.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone VI — When Christ God, the giver of life, raised all of the dead from the valleys of misery with His mighty hand, He bestowed resurrection on the human race: He is the Saviour of all, the resurrection, the life, and the God of all.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Kontakion, Tone IV — As Thou wast, voluntarily, raised upon the cross for our sake, grant mercy to them that are called by Thy name, O Christ God; make all Orthodox Christians glad by thy power, granting them victories over their adversaries, by bestowing, on them, the invincible trophy, Thy weapon of peace.



Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone VII: Extol the Lord our God: / worship at His footstool for He is holy! (Sunday After)

Verse: The Lord reigns, let the people tremble!

pistle: (Galatians 2:16-20) Brethren: knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law; for by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified. ¹⁷ "But if, while we seek to be justified by Christ, we

ourselves also are found sinners, is Christ therefore a minister of sin? Certainly not! ¹⁸ For if I build again those things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor. ¹⁹ For I through the law died to the law that I might live to God. ²⁰ I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

Alleluia Verses:

Remember Thy congregation, which Thou hast gotten of old!

God is our King before the ages; He has worked salvation in the midst of the earth!

Gospel: (Mark 8:34-9:1) At that time Jesus called the people to Himself, and said to them, "Whoever desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. ³⁵ For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake and the gospel's will save it. ³⁶ For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? ³⁷ Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul? ³⁸ For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him the Son of Man also will be ashamed when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels." ¹ And He said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you that there are some standing here who will not taste death till they see the kingdom of God present with power."

Instead of "It is truly meet...," we sing: Magnify, O my soul, the most -precious cross of the Lord. Thou art a mystical paradise, O Theotokos, who, though untilled, hast brought forth Christ; through Him, the life-bearing wood of the cross was planted on earth; now, at its exaltation, as we bow in worship before it, we magnify thee.

Communion Hymn: Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest! The light of Thy countenance has been signed upon us, O Lord. Alleluia, Alleluia!
