## **HYMNS & READINGS**

Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone VI — The angelic powers were at Thy tomb; the guards became as dead men: Mary stood by Thy grave, seeking Thy most-pure body; Thou didst capture hell, not being tempted by it: Thou didst come to the Virgin, granting life; O Lord, Who didst rise from the dead, glory to Thee.

**Troparion, Tone I** — When Thou, O Lord, wast baptized in the Jordan, the worship of the Trinity was made manifest: for the voice of the Father bare witness to Thee, and called Thee His beloved Son; and the Spirit, in the form of a dove, confirmed the truthfulness of His word. O Christ our God, Who hast revealed Thyself, and hast enlightened the world, glory to Thee.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, Tone VI — The river Jordan trembled, and was driven back, filled with fear at Thy coming in the flesh: while John drew back in awe, as he fulfilled the ministry of the Spirit: the ranks of angels stood, amazed, when they beheld Thee baptized in the stream: and we, who were in darkness, are filled with light; we praise Thee, O God made manifest, as Thou dost enlighten all.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

**Kontakion, Tone IV** — Today, Thou hast appeared to the universe; and Thy light, O Lord, hath shone on us, who, with understanding, praise Thee: Thou hast come, and revealed Thyself, O light unapproachable.

**PROKEIMENON** - **Tone I:** Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us / as we have set our hope on Thee! (Sunday After)

Verse: Rejoice in the Lord, O you righteous! Praise befits the just!

**PROKEIMENON** - **Tone III:** The Lord is my light and my Saviour: Whom shall I fear? (*Baptism*)

**EPISTLE:** (Ephesians 4:7-13) Brethren, to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift. <sup>8</sup> Therefore He says: "When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, And gave gifts to men." <sup>9</sup> (Now this, "He ascended"—what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth? <sup>10</sup> He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.) <sup>11</sup> And He Himself gave some *to be* apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, <sup>12</sup> for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, <sup>13</sup> till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ;

**Baptism**: (Romans 6:3-11) Brethren, Do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? <sup>4</sup> Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even

so we also should walk in newness of life. <sup>5</sup> For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be *in the likeness* of His resurrection, <sup>6</sup> knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. <sup>7</sup> For he who has died has been freed from sin. <sup>8</sup> Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, <sup>9</sup> knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him. <sup>10</sup> For *the death* that He died, He died to sin once for all; but *the life* that He lives, He lives to God. <sup>11</sup> Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**ALLELUIA VERSES:** I will sing of Thy mercies, O Lord, forever; with my mouth I will proclaim Thy truth from generation to generation. • For Thou hast said: Mercy will be established forever; Thy truth will be prepared in the heavens. • Light dawns for the righteous, and joy for the upright in heart.

GOSPEL: (Matthew 4:12-17) At that time, Now when Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, He departed to Galilee. <sup>13</sup> And leaving Nazareth, He came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the regions of Zebulun and Naphtali, <sup>14</sup> that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: <sup>15</sup> "The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, By the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles: <sup>16</sup> The people who sat in darkness have seen a great light, And upon those who sat in the region and shadow of death Light has dawned." <sup>17</sup> From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

**Baptism**: (Matthew 28:16-20) At that time, the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, to the mountain which Jesus had appointed for them. <sup>17</sup> When they saw Him, they worshiped Him; but some doubted. <sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

IN PLACE OF IT IS TRULY MEET — Magnify, O my soul, the most -pure Virgin Theotokos, more honourable than the heavenly hosts. No tongue knows how to praise thee worthily, O Theotokos; even angels are overcome with awe praising thee; but, since thou art good, accept our faith: for thou knowest our love inspired by God: thou art the defender of Christians; and we magnify thee.

COMMUNION HYMN: Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest! The righteous shall be in everlasting remembrance! He shall not fear evil tidings! *Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia!*
